Here are some of the responses gathered by the artists on the Creative Carriage.

TRANSPORT

- ❑ The trains and tube need policing at night because they don't feel safe
- ❑ Glasgow's close to Edinburgh and the seaside and has great access to other countries through Glasgow and Prestwick Airports
- ❑ The clockwork orange underground system is tiny compared to other metros. We don't access the airport or other parts of the city.
- ❑ Public transport could be cleaner
- ❑ Politicians have been talking about extending the transport links for 10 years and nothing happened yet

CULTURAL PROVISION

- ❑ I want to see more jazz music and less rubbish like Franz Ferdinand, so more jazz would be good. I think Glasgow would be a great jazz city.
- ❑ Glasgow's a really friendly city but it has gone downhill since it won the city of architecture, so they should invest some money in cultural activities like arts and drama.
- ❑ What I love about Glasgow is the friendliness of the people. I think it's got such a lot to offer in terms of magnificent buildings. The range of culture you can get here is second to none. I just wish people would value it more when they're there.
- ❑ Concessionary train fares between Edinburgh and Glasgow with the purchase of Gallery tickets.
- ❑ There's loads of money spent on the regeneration of areas in the city and it looks really good, but there's not enough money invested in bringing high profile events like fashion and stuff to the city to let people see the improvements and to bring other people to it.
- ❑ Better shopping, friendly people, the universities are really good

- ❑ Traditionally there's a rivalry between Glasgow and Edinburgh. They should work together to achieve things because they're in easy reach and both are big cities.
- ❑ Late licenses should be granted to clubs that have proven they don't generate violent behaviours.
- ❑ A lot of art students leave this city to study and we should try to keep them, especially in drama and fashion where we have really good courses available.
- ❑ There's a lot to do, a good music scene and good shopping.
- ❑ Lots to do in terms of arts.
- ❑ The city centre is divided by music styles and it's not a good situation.
- ❑ Celtic and rangers has become less about sport and too much about religion.

COMMUNITY SAFETY

- ❑ I'd like to see an end to what I call gender based violence. That includes young men in the streets fighting with each other but also includes male violence against women. That's what I really want to see end.
- ❑ Less violence on match day
- ❑ Gang Culture. Give kids something to do to avoid their involvement in gangs.

ENVIRONMENT

- ❑ We need many, many, many, less cars on the road, we should all be walking around this beautiful city and if not walking, taking the bus or the tube.
- ❑ They need to tidy up the streets because it's getting quite dirty.
- ❑ Clear up all the litter
- ❑ I think the smoking ban should be extended to cover all public places, indoors and out as the litter it causes contributes to making the city unclean and unhealthy.
- ❑ Glasgow needs to be more glamorous. It hasn't had a great image in the past and now it's really polluted. People need to grasp that we need to do something about this. Trams would be a good start, they'd help reduce pollution and we could introduce more green areas, there are a lot already, but you can never have too much.

- There's an awful lot of noise and I think there should be policing through the night to combat it.
- When you get into the city, it's very smoggy.

WELFARE

- Glasgow has a problem with poverty, but it's not seen, it's been pushed out onto the outskirts of the city, so there should be a greater awareness of the issues of poverty and homelessness.
- I'd like to see all our young people doing well in school because we have loads of jobs in Glasgow and they should be the first to benefit in the future.

PUBLIC SERVICES

- Sort the hospitals out. The waiting rooms are filled with litter and things so they should try and clear up the mess.
